Dr. Mehmet Ali Kökpınar obtained his PhD (1996), MSc (1990) and BSc (1988) degrees in Civil Engineering from Middle East Technical University (METU), Ankara-Turkey. Since 2006, he is an Associate Professor in Hydraulics. He worked for General Directorate of State Hydraulic Works, Turkey, between 1997 and 2016. His research interests include air-water flow in hydraulic structures, sediment transport and local scour, sediment transport in pipes, reservoir sedimentation and design of hydraulic structures. His international publications include more than 30 journal and conference papers. He is an individual member of IAHR (International Association of Hydro-Environment Engineering and Research) and served as a member for two terms (2010-2011 and 2012-2013) in the IAHR-Europe Leadership Team.
